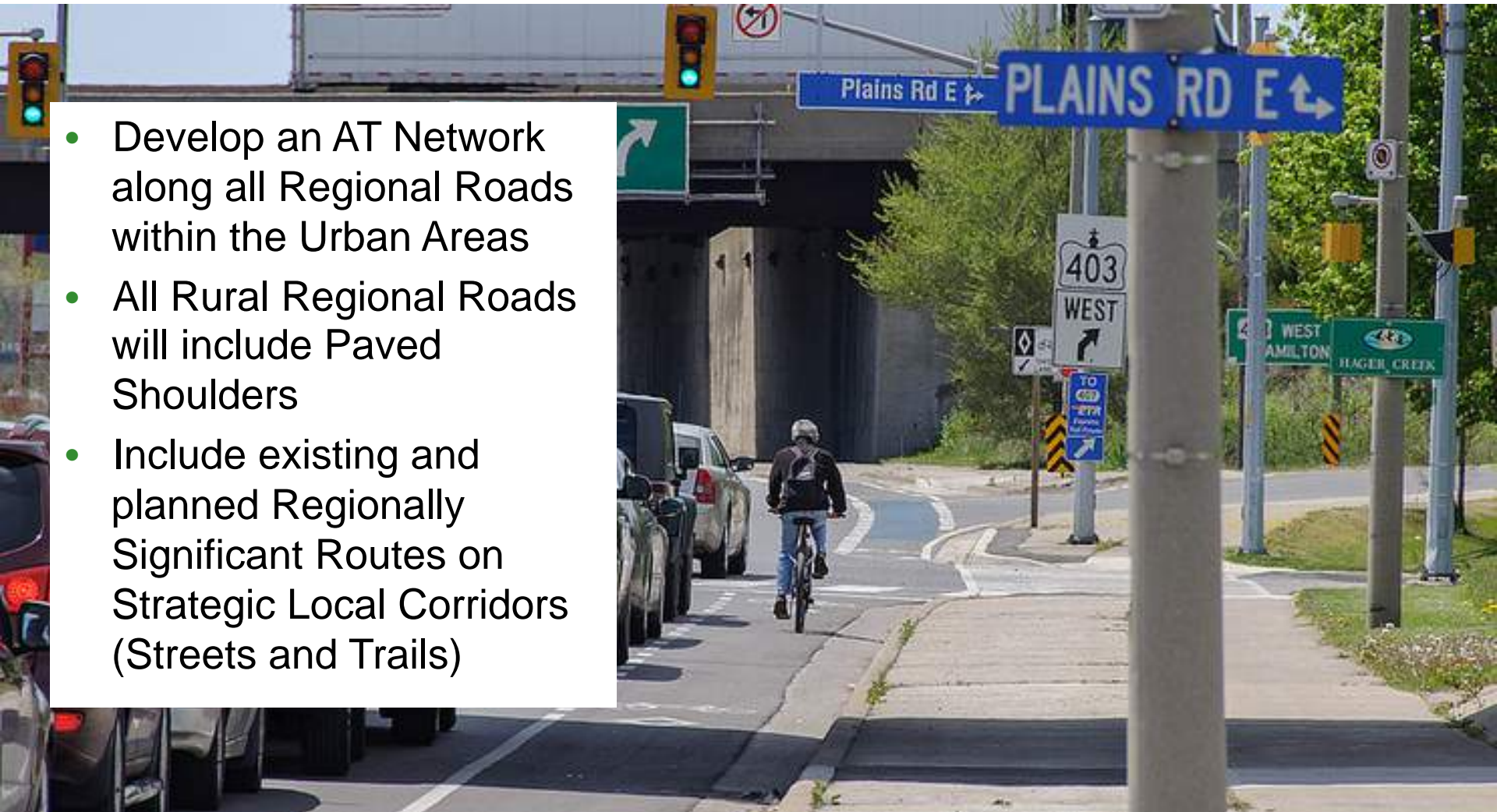


Halton **ACTIVE** Transportation Master Plan

- All Rural Regional Roads will include Paved Shoulders
- Include existing and planned Regionally Significant Routes on Strategic Local Corridors (Streets and Trails)

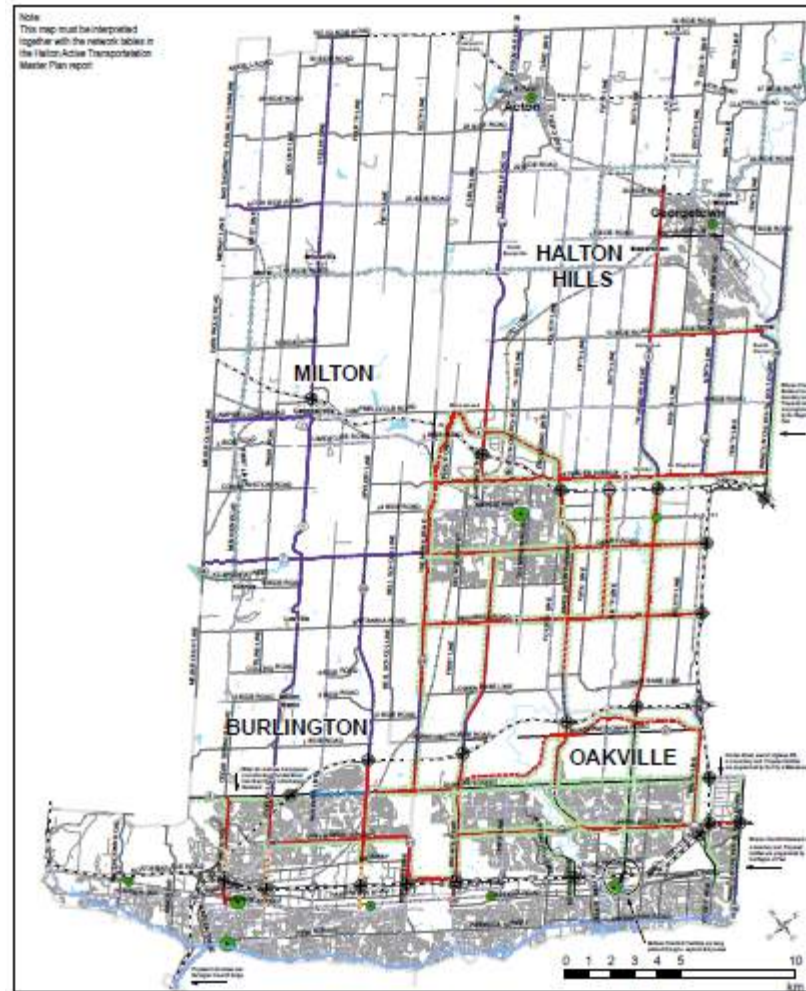

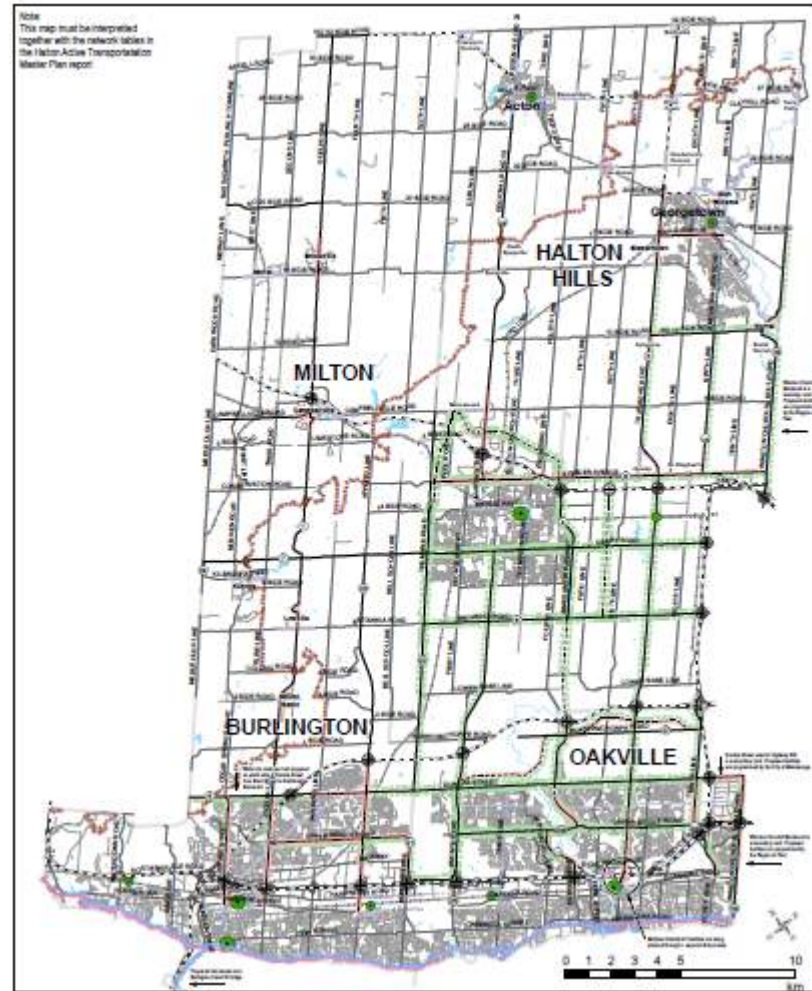

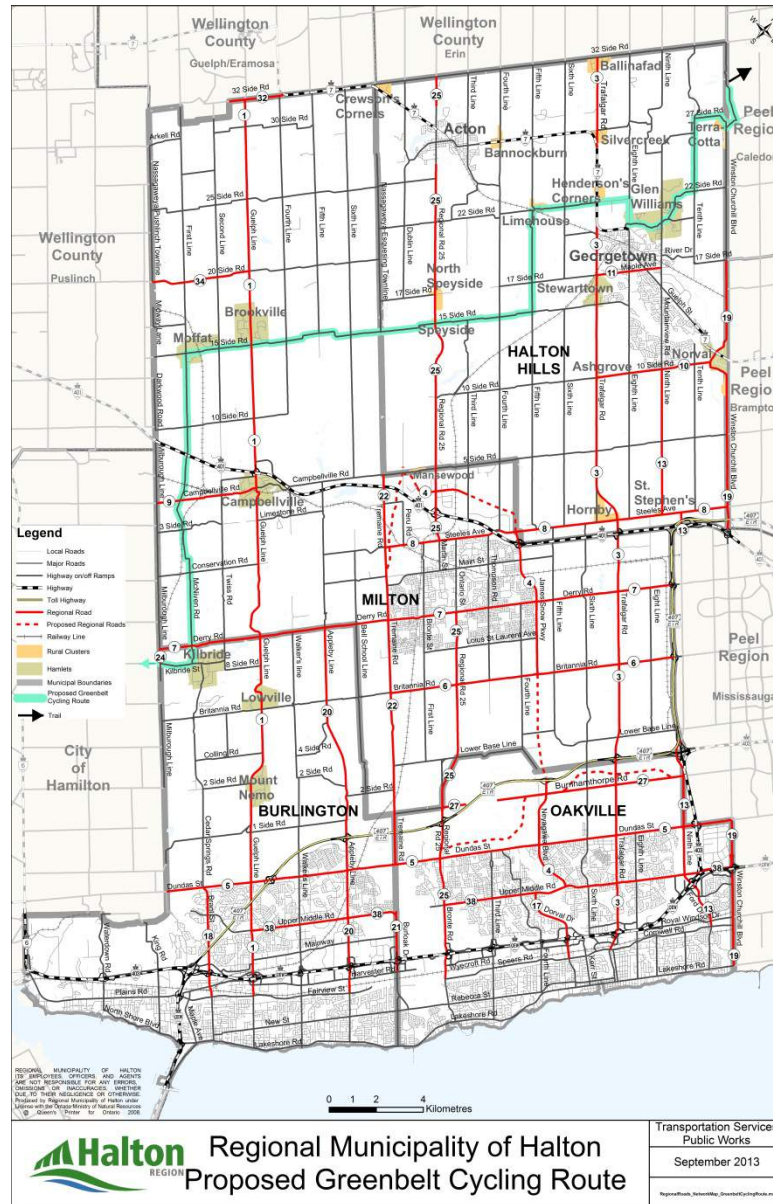

Town of Halton Hills Cycling Initiatives

- Way-finding signage pilot project
- Up-grading chip and tar to micro paving on rural roads to accommodate cyclists
- Bike lanes added to Highway 7 in Acton
- Multi- Use Path added to Steeles Ave from Milton to Premium Outlets
- Bike Lanes added to 17th Side Road

Halton Hills Cycling Initiatives

- Partnering with Chamber of Commerce and BIA's to identify and encourage bicycle friendly businesses
- Encouraging the Region to complete a new tourism based cycling map
- Partnering with Epic Tour Halton to establish a GTA Granfondo signature cycle tourism event

- Established a Bicycle Friendly Community Committee
- Hosting Community Cycling Events
- Cycling Safety Instruction for kids
- HH Community Cycling Challenge
- Complete Streets philosophy
