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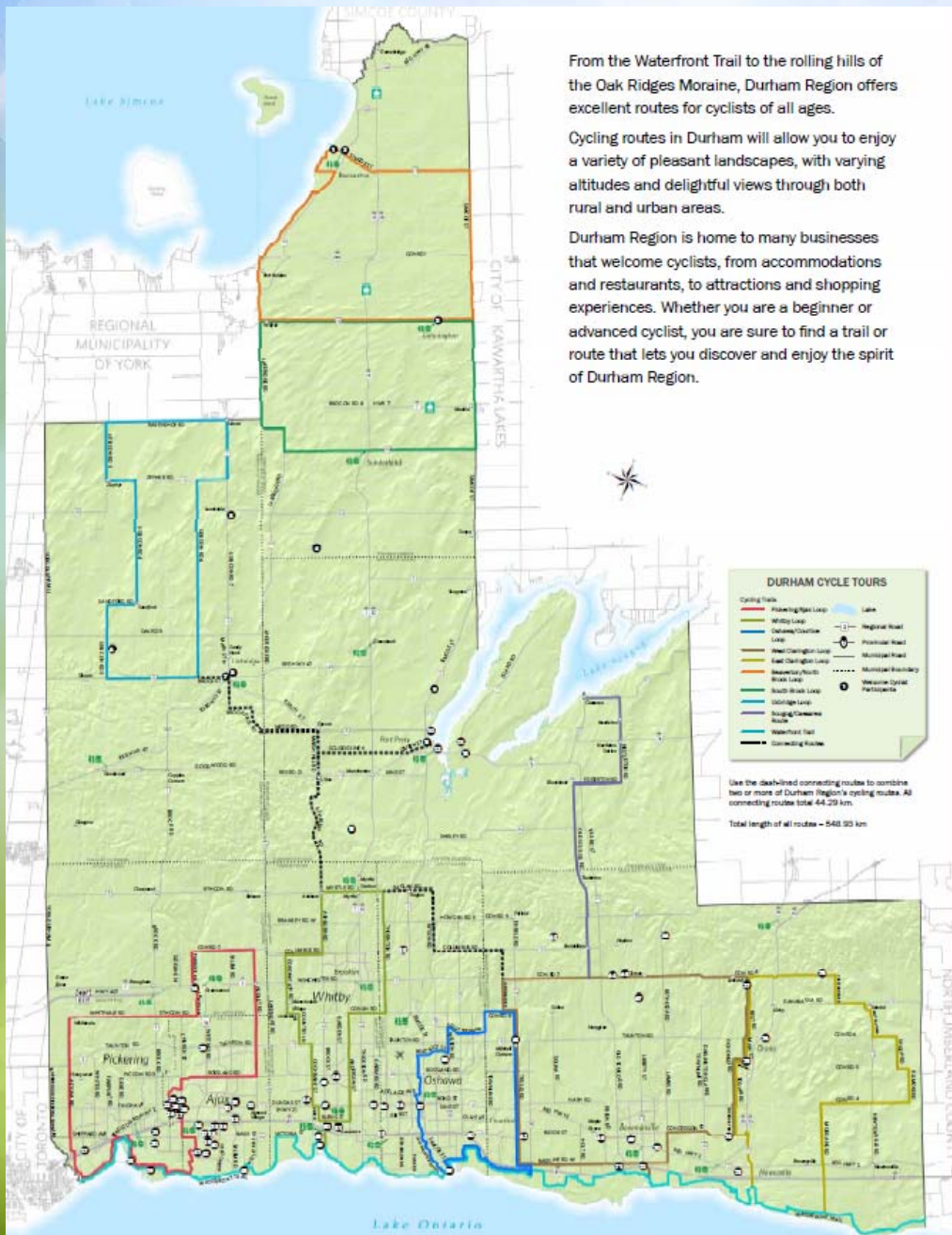

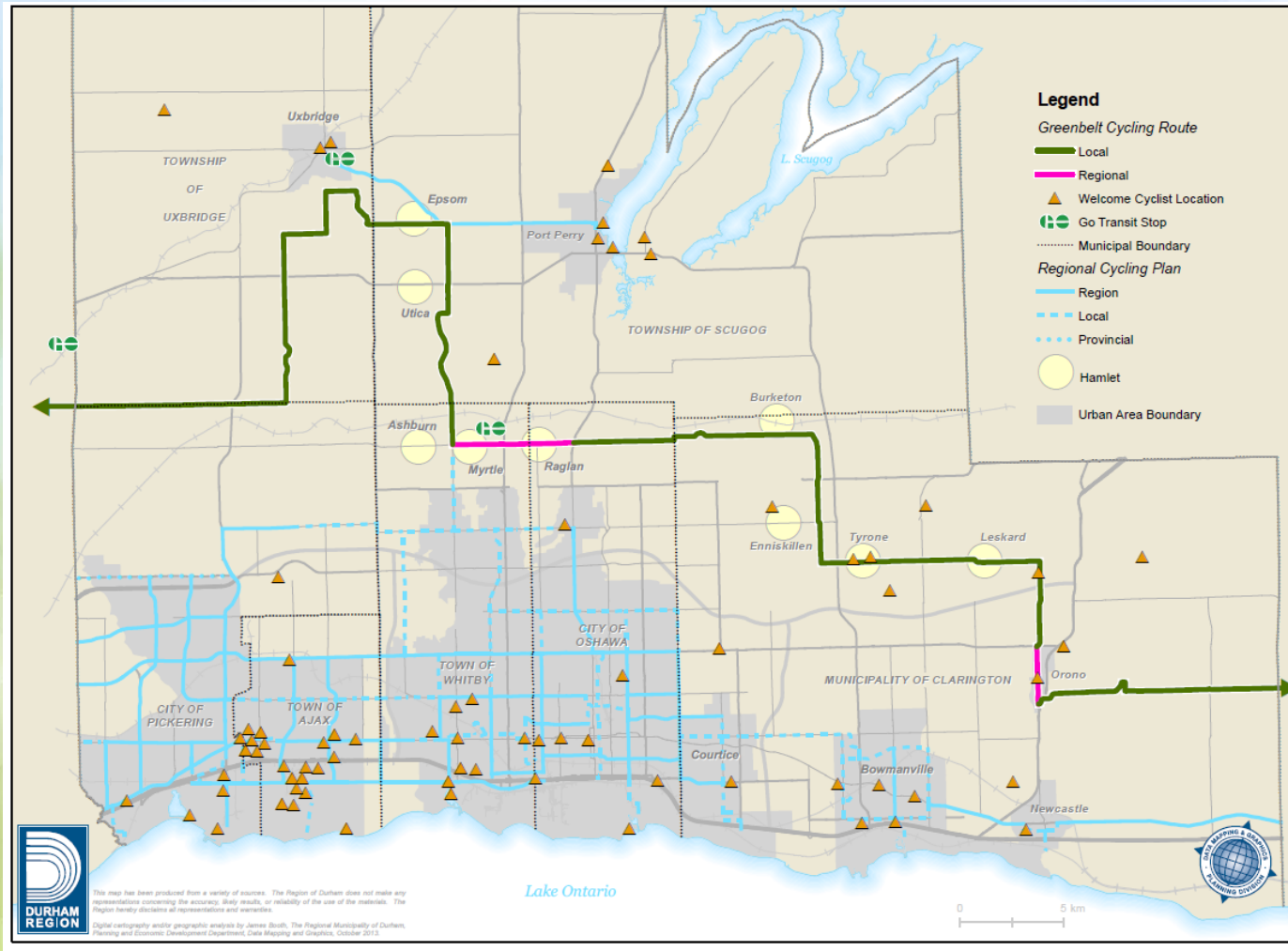
From the Waterfront Trail to the rolling hills of the Oak Ridges Moraine, Durham Region offers excellent routes for cyclists of all ages.
